

Moving Beyond the Stalemate? Prospects for Peace in the Middle East

Thanks to the generosity of the Atkin Foundation, ICSR has been offering young leaders from Israel and Arab countries the opportunity to come to London for periods of four months to engage in research, debate and constructive dialogue about the conflict in the Middle East.

Together with ICSR, this year's Atkin Fellows - two Israelis and two Palestinians - are organising a one-day symposium on 'Prospects for Peace'. The idea is to bring together leading thinkers and policymakers to analyse the current situation and discuss opportunities for how to move it forward.

The objective is to understand the new situation, taking into account:

- The new government in Israel
- Ongoing changes among the Palestinian leadership
- The new administration in the United States
- Significant developments among neighbouring Arab states, for example the Arab Peace Initiative and the potential for reaching out to Syria

The aim is to identify areas of convergence between different actors, and develop ideas for how these can be exploited in order to further the cause of a peaceful settlement.

The symposium will result in a short action paper put together by the Atkin Fellows and ICSR staff. The paper will be published and disseminated among policymakers currently engaged in formulating policy on the region.
